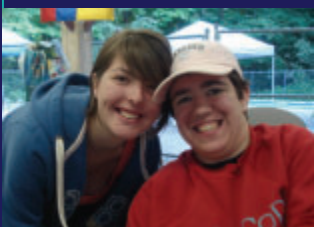

We offer a variety of Respite Services to meet the schedule needs of working families and caregivers of individuals with disabilities, as well as to provide them with a break from the constant care and everyday routines.

After School & Vacation Respite Services

Albany After School Program:

Located at the Center's 314 S. Manning Blvd. Site, the Albany After School Program is an 'Hourly Respite' for school aged individuals, ages 3 to 21years, with a diagnosis of a developmental disability. Albany After School provides recreational programming for individuals including use of the sites pool, playground, gym and classroom activities. This program operates Monday-Friday from 3:00 pm to 5:30pm according to the Children's Services School Calendar. **For more information, call: 518-437-5540**

Albany School Vacation Program (GAP):

This is an 'Hourly Respite' located at the Center's 314 S. Manning Blvd. Site, which offers recreational programming for individuals during school breaks. This program serves school aged individuals, ages 3 to 21years, who have a diagnosis of a developmental disability. The School Vacation Program operates according to the Children's Services School Calendar breaks, Monday-Friday, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. **For more information, call: 518-437-5540**

Schenectady After School Program:

Located at the Paige Elementary School in the Schenectady City School District this after school program is a "Hourly Respite" for school aged individuals with a diagnosis of a developmental disability. The Schenectady after school program provides recreational programming for individuals. This program operates Monday - Friday according to the Schenectady City School District calendar. **For more information, call: 518-437-5540**

Charles Park After School & After Work Respite and Vacation Program:

Located at Charles Park in Guilderland, the Charles Park After School & Vacation Program is an 'Hourly Respite' Program for individuals aged 12-21 with a diagnosis of a developmental disability. The After Work Program is for individuals aged 21 and older. The programs, which are community based, provide a safe setting for recreation and socialization after school or day program. The programs utilize community resources in the Guilderland area such as the YMCA and bowling alley. The program operates Monday-Friday, 2:00-6:00pm and 8:00am-6:00pm on school vacation days. **For more information, call (518) 456-5669, ext. 404.**

Overnight & Weekend Respite Services

Overnight Respite:

Located in Guilderland, our Overnight Respite Program operates 7 days a week for those ages 6 and older. **For more information, call (518) 456-0559.**

Community Skills Respite

Community Skills Respite, a waiver hourly respite program, offers community participation through a variety of supervised recreational activities to foster peer interaction and development of skills to increase independence for individuals with developmental disabilities.

Medicaid Waiver In-Home Respite

Medicaid Waiver approved participants, who live at home with other family members, are eligible for In-Home Respite services. Services provided are a respite to the caregiver(s) and consist of in-home recreation and in-home skill building for the participant. In-Home Respite does not offer overnight services.
