Re: Important Update on Psychiatry Services at CFDS

Dear Patient/Caregiver,

We are writing to share important news about psychiatry services at the Center for Disability Services (CFDS). CFDS plans to stop offering psychiatry services at Center Health Care on December 31, 2025. No other services offered by CFDS are impacted by this change.

This may be the first time you are hearing this information, and we want to explain what it means for you. Because you live independently in the community, we recommend that you work with your **Care Coordination Organization (CCO)** or other program in your area that can help you take the next steps in your care. These groups will work with you to find new psychiatry services that fit your needs.
